



## IEEE JRFID Special Issue on “IEEE RFID-TA 2025 Conference”

The IEEE RFID-TA 2025 JRFID Special Issue will contain **EXTENDED VERSIONS** of papers presented at the IEEE RFID-TA 2025 Conference. The manuscript **MUST be significantly extended** beyond the scope of the conference paper in terms of the overall TECHNICAL content and research results.

**The submission deadline is January 31, 2026.** Nevertheless, submissions well in advance with respect to the deadline are strongly encouraged, since the papers will be published in Early Access on IEEE Xplore as soon as they are accepted. They will appear under the Topic “Selected Papers from the 2025 IEEE International Conference on RFID Technology and Applications” in IEEE Xplore.

**Publication of the Special Issue: Mid 2026**

**Publication on IEEE Xplore: in Early Access as soon as the paper is accepted**

### Submission guidelines

The following requirements must be satisfied when submitting the manuscript.

1. The **MANUSCRIPT MUST BE TECHNICALLY EXTENDED** beyond the scope of the conference paper, as mentioned above. The novel contribution with respect to the conference paper has to be properly declared and possibly highlighted in a different colour. The conference paper **must** be listed as one of the references in the special-issue manuscript and clearly referred through the text.
2. At the time of submission, the authors must provide in the **COVER LETTER** detailed information regarding how the manuscript is a technically extended version of the conference paper.
3. A **PDF copy of the conference paper** must also be submitted.

The manuscript must be formatted according to the template available at <https://journals.ieeeauthorcenter.ieee.org/> and must be submitted electronically using the Author Portal (<https://authorgateway.ieee.org/ag/public/landing.jsp>), together with the accompanying documents (i.e. cover letter, conference paper and IEEE copyright transfer form).
